The Far Eastern University was first established as "Far Eastern College" on December 27, 1999 with permission from the Commission on Higher Education (formerly the Ministry of University Affairs) and officially opened on February 4, 2000. Her Royal Highness Princess Kalyaniwattana presided over the official opening of the university on November 13, 2001.

Because of its strong ambition and continuous emphasis on education, the university was granted the title "The Far Eastern University" on April 20, 2006 and a declaration ceremony was held on May 8, 2006.

While complying with Thai government policy on education, The Far Eastern University aims to arm its students with the knowledge and abilities needed to compete in the globalizing world. The Far Eastern University also puts its utmost effort in training its students in the most cutting edge technology while also equipping them with international business skills and a spirit of entrepreneurship. - **Outer circle:** The outer circle represents the unfathomed knowledge and development that our students will obtain throughout their whole lives as there is neither a beginning nor end to the circle.

- **Inner circle:** The inner circle is comprised of an ancient, three bar scale that symbolizes the harmony of the whole person's development. The bars include:

Ethics: each student must possess an ethical mind in all areas

Wisdom: each student must be a life-long scholar who always searches for knowledge that can be used to enhance his or her life as well as both the local global community

Wholeness: each student must examine his or her actions in order to prepare themselves to be a complete person who thinks and performs tasks thoroughly and fairly

Location

The Far Eastern University sits on approximately 10 Rai of land at 120 Mahidol Road in Muang District, Chiang Mai. The university holds 2 modern five-floor buildings, a convention hall of more than 700 seats, an audio-visual room, a computer lab, a multi-purpose sports complex, a language lab, a cafeteria, parking space, and the Wattanarachanakarin 80 Building.

Also, in order to facilitate the growth of students, we have extended the campus with another modern five-floor building constructed on 104 rai in Handong District and is equipped with many of the same amenities as our other campus as well as a stadium and dormitories.
